Article 1614aa

- **1.** Articles 646 to 649 of Book 7 of the Dutch Civil Code, with the exception of articles 646, paragraph 1, second sentence, 648, paragraph 3 and 649, paragraph 3, apply *mutatis mutandis*.
- 2. If an employer terminates an employment contract in contravention of the articles referred to in paragraph 1 or on the grounds that the employee has invoked the provisions of paragraph 1 either at law or otherwise or has provided assistance in this connection, the termination is voidable.
- **3.** If an employee does not invoke this ground for annulment within two months of the termination of the employment contract, his right to do so lapses.
- **4.** Any legal claim in connection with the annulment is subject to a limitation period of six months from the date on which the termination took effect.
- **5.** A termination as referred to in paragraph 2 does not render the employer liable to pay compensation.
